Dec 1-3 the Vida Nueva church hosted a clinic to train teachers from 15 churches to in turn, train the children in their church to clearly and simply share their faith with other children. This was headed up by Marisol Marquez who is one of the implementers of the Global Development Project that Guillermo coaches.

A total of 69 children individually made professions of faith in 2 planned events: 1. the presentation of a Bible story by chalk art and puppets in the down-town of Zihuatanejo . 2. A visit to the makeshift school at the municipal trash dump. In the picture you can see the children at the trash dump and the EE trainees.
