Daniel, Fernando, Uriel, Miguel, Hania, Ismael, Miriam, and Enelicia are eight children ranging from 21 months to 14 years who have been given a home and loving and caring ‘parents’ in Gabriel and Marlene Vazquez. They are dedicated servants of the Lord that will bring these children up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord and teach them a trade in order to be able to work when they become of age.

These children have come from ‘homes’ where they have been neglected and abused. Right now they are going through adjustments to the changes of having 3 meals a day, a bed to sleep in, a Christian school to attend and people who really and truly care for them. All in this home need your prayer support.

## A change of focus

With God supplying the house parents, Gabriel and Marlene, our daughter, Sarah Grace, does not have the same responsibilities in administration of the children’s home. She has now assumed the responsibility of publicity/ public relations which will involve taking pictures, working on a website, making the needs known and informing people here and away of how they can contribute to this ministry. She would appreciate your prayers that God would help her organize well her time to give the best that she can to this endeavor.

## Persevering in Prayer

Because this ministry has been started by faith, there are many needs that we are asking God to provide. He has answered your faithful prayers and provided the home, some of the children ( we are hoping to be able to house up to 20 in this house) and the house parents. Because you have been so faithful to pray we would ask you to pray with us that other material needs can be met. They are as follows: Bibles and Bible story books for each child according to their age, ceiling fans, interior/exterior paint, beds and mattresses (20) computers (10), construction of more bedrooms, construction of a better fence, work on the electric wiring, cushions for the living room, clothes and shoes for the children, commodes and another shower, industrial stove, tables and chairs

for the computers, swing sets and play ground sets, curtains and sheets, pillows, dining room chairs, educational material, projector for videos, sound system, lights and lamps and plumbing repair. There is a group of university students that is planning on coming in May to work on the chil-
