There was blessed fellowship with the Reformed Church of New Zealand. Steve, a young New Zealander, a devoted "Street Preacher," is applying to GPTS to prepare for the Gospel ministry. Give thanks to God for allowing us to reach so many lost, hurting and confused people. The Police didn't question our right to preach the Gospel in our Father's world, and thousand's of pieces of gospel literature were providentially placed in the hands and hearts of those known unto God. We preached in Queens Street, Auckland and at the University of Auckland, as well as outside Starbucks. We even walked into a park to find hundreds of newly graduated students, many of whom were Chinese, celebrating with their families. We joined in the celebration, congratulating the students and giving them our graduation gifts of Gospel literature. We also took turns to preach for a couple of hours. Some of the students believed that we were part of the program. It is impossible to even recall and report all the divine appointments and talks we had with folks as we walked through the day. We were on the streets from 12 noon until 8.00 PM each day for 12 days and there were seven of us, as well as local pastors who joined us for the time that they could spare, along with local Christians. We were also able to make contact with local Christians, a number of whom were discouraged "Street Preachers." We encouraged them!
