Next her simple but bold question, “*Now, about this being ‘born-again’ business...*” “Yes, and answer to my prayers for His divine appointment with someone He is calling to Himself – and yes, I still stand amazed at how our Lord does this! Carolyn and I were able to spend some time together. The Lord taught her a deep truth about her obedience and His revelation. “*Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves Me. He who loves Me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show Myself to him.*” John 14:21 came alive to her... obedience brings His revelation of Himself... to me! We all need to hold-on to that truth. Amen? She has been sent to an Arkansas prison. Please pray for her growth in truth and faithfulness. I believe she got it. Hallelujah, what a Savior!

He has given me a sweeter, greater sense of His presence and call to a deeper more consecrated walk with Him. Very humbling. Please pray for me to be faithful and joyfully quick in obedience, in whatever lies ahead; that I will remember: “*The One Who calls you is faithful and He will do it.*” I Thess. 5:24
